In addition to calculating cash and credit sales and making change, Farmers Market Volunteers will assist with set-up, organization, and take-down, and promote the Friends of the Library while visiting with customers, and through word of mouth.

Qualifications for this position include ability to handle money and make change. Volunteer should be friendly, dependable, punctual, and enjoy reading and working with the public.

Time Commitment for this position is a minimum of twice a month from 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. All adult volunteers should be able to make at least a six-month commitment to the Library.
